



SOCCER GOALKEEPER CAMP

BOYS' & GIRLS' SESSIONS FROM 3:00–4:45

This camp is designed for the middle school- or high school-aged player who is learning to be a goalkeeper or who has played goalkeeper but has had little formal training at this position

This camp will teach the basic skills of goalkeeping and also help intermediate goalkeepers achieve the next level of play

Instructional points will include proper techniques for catching, punching, tipping, diving, and distributing (kicking, punting, and throwing). Players will also learn how to cut-down angles, set-up the defense for walls and corner kicks, deal with breakaways, increase their chances on saving penalty kicks, etc.

Goalkeepers will be taught how to "read" the game so that they will be able to anticipate their next moves without having to resort to the desperate or spectacular

Goalkeepers will also become familiar with the Laws of the Game and how they relate to their unique position
